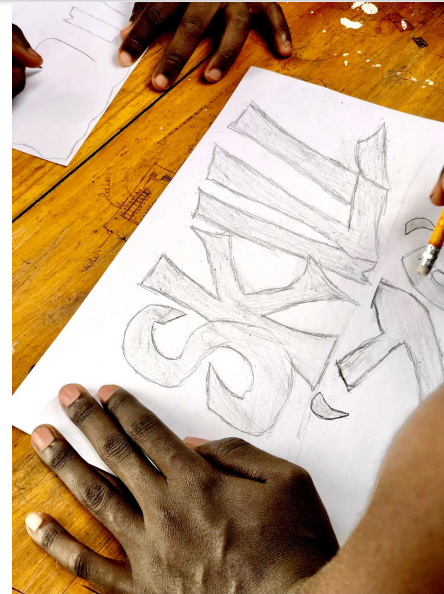
Welcome to our newsletter of

We taught a graffiti focused session to 29 students of year 4 at Rainbow International school. Our lesson exposed and introduced students to lettering styles within graffiti, covering elements like letter structure – skeleton and body; Composition on how they would look like either in bubble shapes or and other. With Alphabet, they did throwers and each had to sketch them in their books then on an A4 size plywood board for their final piece.

The participants enjoyed our basic yet unique and learnable content, and teaching style. We want to increase opportunities for young people to access and practice creative activities.





Through our efforts towards arts, culture and creative development, our director paid courtesy visits to 2 community based programs in village areas of Jinja district.

Omulandira (root) arts foundation at masese landing side and Tusobora (we can) arts academy at walukuba. Both projects use dance as the fabric of their programming to grow artistic and social skills among their activities participants.

We are going to collaborate with these community based programs, offering them capacity development for their instructors.

Between September and November, we provided over 70 instructed sessions and engaged over 100 young people in our activities at schools, community organizations, events and outreaches. We offered productive employment to 10+ artists/creative educators.
